The Friends group was set up in 1989 to promote the proper maintenance and enhancement of Homeyards Botanical Gardens. It has since become a registered charity and its trustees and committee meet several times a year. A good relationship with the Gardens' owners, Teignbridge DC is fostered and we are members of and have the support of Devon Gardens Trust. We are a point of contact for garden users keeping an eye on issues and supplementing the basic council maintenance work to the extent that a Green Flag award has been made for some years now.

Projects have included a major HLF scheme which helped restore the derelict castle, renewal of oak gates, setting up a new filtration system for the pond and planting schemes that have rejuvenated areas and introduced specimen trees and plantings. The landscape is now so improved that a dedicated gardener is employed 2 days a week and funded by Shaldon Parish Council. The gardens have provided the perfect setting for events such as outdoor music and theatre as well as the popular free Easter and Autumn children's entertainments organised by the Friends.
